Mus. D	Doctor of Music
Sc. D	Doctor of Science

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the procedure for selection of the candidates for these degrees be as follows:

 Nominations shall be submitted to the President for consideration.

- The President shall refer all nominations to a faculty committee which shall submit for his approval those names, in the opinion of the committee, that are appropriate for consideration by the Board.
- 3. From among those names the President shall submit no more than two to the Board of Trustees by March of any academic year for consideration as awardees at the ensuing commencement.
