Census taker positions pay \$16.51 per hour and crew leaders earn \$18.76 per hour. Applicants are required to have access to reliable transportation and anyone over the age of 18 can apply. Men must have registered with the Selective Service. Residents of St. John and Water Island are urged to apply.

Beginning in March, census takers will visit every household in the territory to complete census forms.
