#### INTRODUCTION


- Argos is a powerful reporting tool designed to be used by the novice user to the advance technical user to build and deploy reports and dashboards across the enterprise.
- Argos is divided into three types of users
  - DataBlock Designers "power users" who create DataBlocks
  - Report Writers intermediate users who use DataBlocks to build a variety of reports
  - Report Viewers casual users who run reports and save and distribute the output in a variety of useful formats.

#### GETTING STARTED

- To launch Argos application login to myCampus.uvi.edu using your UVI network login credentials.
- Locate the Argos icon ( ) under the Staff Launchpad menu (located on the left-hand side of the screen) on the myCampus homepage.
- Click the Argos link to navigate to the Argos launchpage.
  - Argos is single sign-on (SSO), therefore, once you launch Argos from myCampus, no additional login information is required.


## EVISIONS LAUNCH PAGE

As a report viewer, you will run reports via Argos Web Viewer. To launch Argos Web Viewer, click the Argos Web Viewer Button.




## OARGOS WEB VIEWER

• The Web Viewer allows users to run Argos dashboards and reports in your browser.




## DARGOS WEB VIEWER - SEARCH

• Enter a name or partial name to locate folders, reports, and DataBlocks that match your search terms.



## DARGOS WEB VIEWER - EXPLORER PANE

 The Explorer pane displays a list of folders. Click on a folder to view its contents




## PARGOS WEB VIEWER - SHORTCUTS TAB

• Quick access to heavily used DataBlocks or reports. To add a DataBlock or report to the Shortcuts tab, click the star icon to the left of any DataBlock or report.




#### DARGOS WEB VIEWER - RECENT TAB

• The Recent tab is a convenient way to get back to the last 10 DataBlocks and reports you ran.



#### DARGOS WEB VIEWER - CONTENT PANE

• The Content pane shows the DataBlocks and reports in the current folder.



### DARGOS WEB VIEWER - NAVIGATION

- Click the Home button to go back to the root folder.
- You can see your current location by looking at the breadcrumb trail at the top of the screen. Click on any folder in the breadcrumb to jump to that location.



## WHAT IS A DATABLOCK?

- A DataBlock is the foundation from which all reports are created. They contains user input forms and queries to retrieve information from one or more data sources.
- A DataBlock is essentially acts as the "parent" of a report and a DataBlock can contain multiple "child' reports.
- In Argos, a DataBlock is denoted by the following icon:



## DATABLOCKS (CONT'D)

- A DataBlock contains various formats to view information.
  - Dashboards display-only reports for quick reference
  - CSV Report A comma-separated values report (Excel)
  - Banded Report a fully formatted report
  - Extract Report A text report that meets pre-defined specifications
  - Schedule reports may be scheduled to run automatically
