


Figure 2.1 New Student Admissions Data Comparisons Fall 1999-2002




Figure 2.2 St. Thomas Admissions Data Comparisons Fall 1999-2002




Figure 2.3 St. Croix Admissions Data Comparisons Fall 1999-2002

Figure 2.4 Total Headcount Enrollment Fall 1993-2002






Figure 2.5 Undergraduate Full-time Equivalent Fall 1993-2002






Figure 2.8 UVI Full-time Undergraduate Enrollment by Class Fall 1993-2002




Figure 2.9 Full-time Undergraduate Enrollment by Campus Fall 1993-2002
