


Figure 6.1 Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Campus Fall 1998-2002




Figure 6.3 UVI Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Ethnic Origin Fall 1998-2002



Figure 6.4 UVI Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Highest Degree Fall 1998-2002


