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Figure 1.2 Headcount Enrollment by Campus and Gender Fall 2003




Figure 1.3 Headcount Enrollment by Campus, Gender and Status Fall 2003



Figure 1.4 Undergraduate Enrollment by Division Fall 2003



Figure 1.5 Enrollment by Class Fall 2003


