Figure 7.1 Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Campus Fall 2000-2004




Figure 7.2 UVI Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Gender Fall 2000-2004

Figure 7.3 UVI Full-Time Instructional Faculty by Ethnic Origin Fall 2000-2004



Figure 7.5 UVI Full-time Instructional Faculty by Rank Fall 2004


