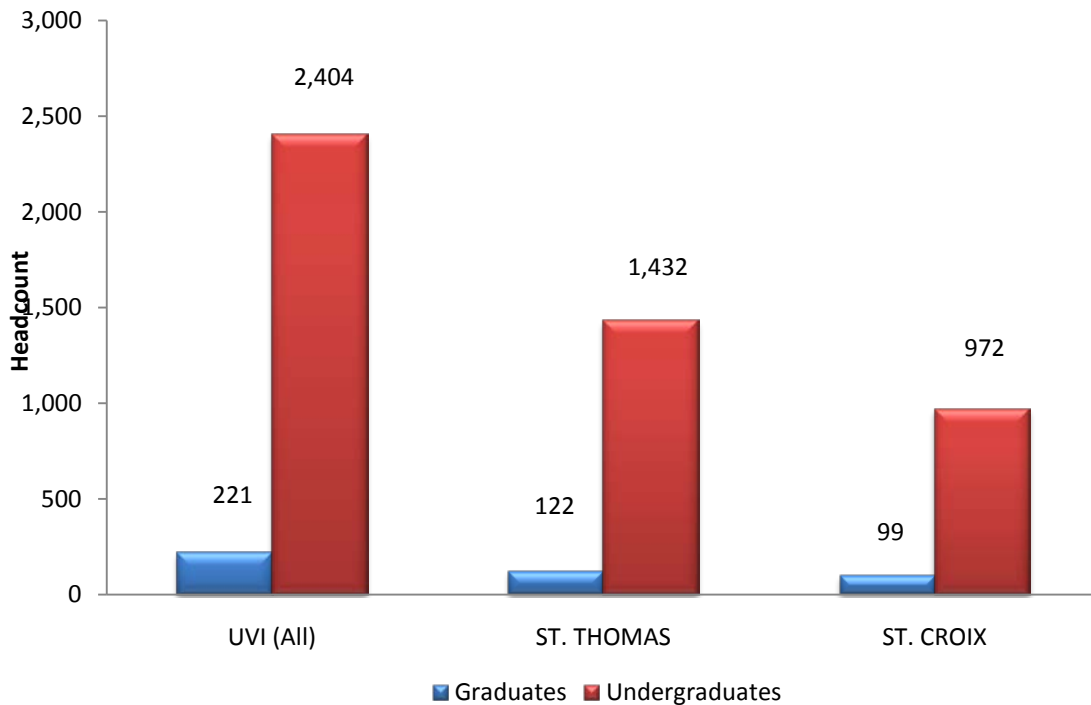


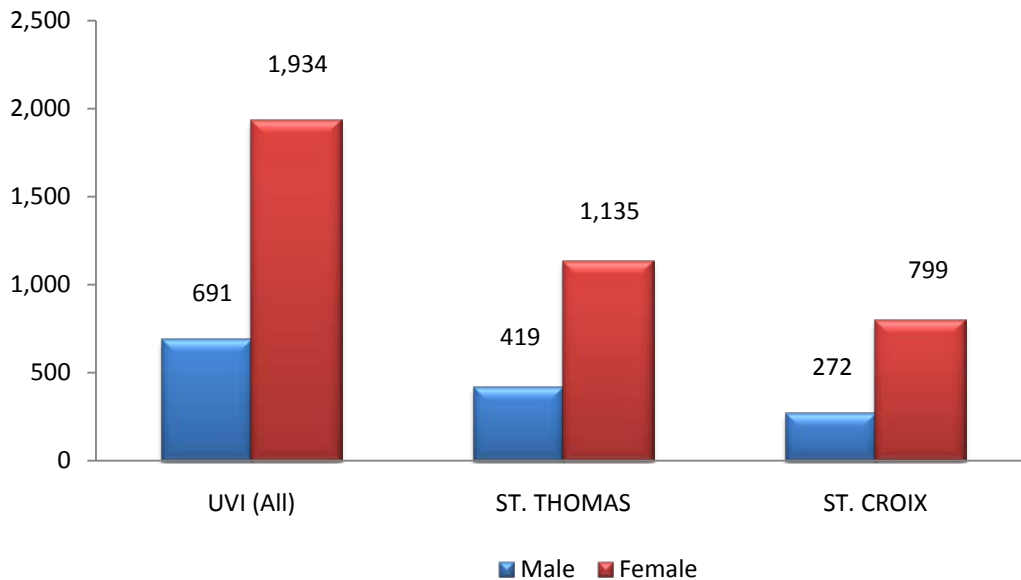

**Figure 1.1c Headcount Enrollment by Campus, Gender and Status Spring 2011**

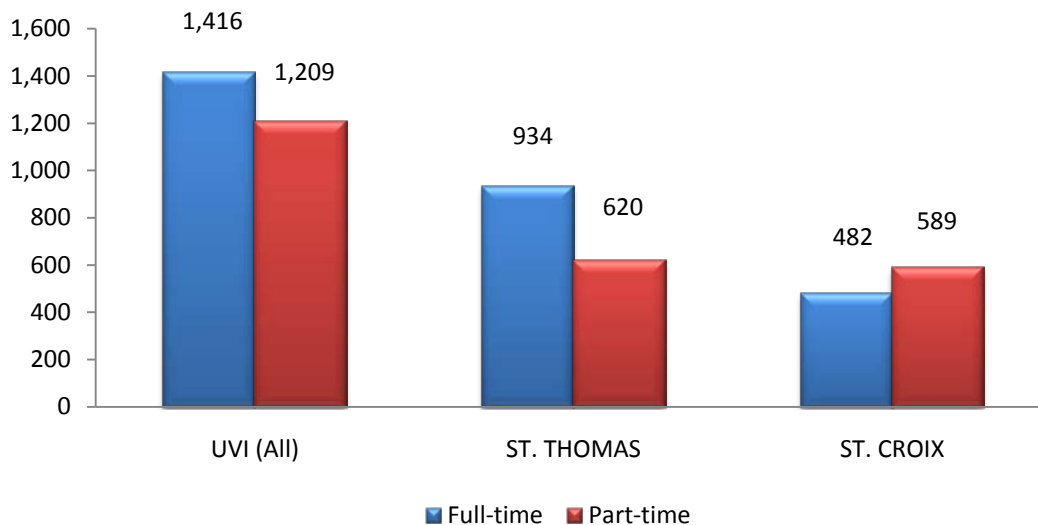

Spring 2011**

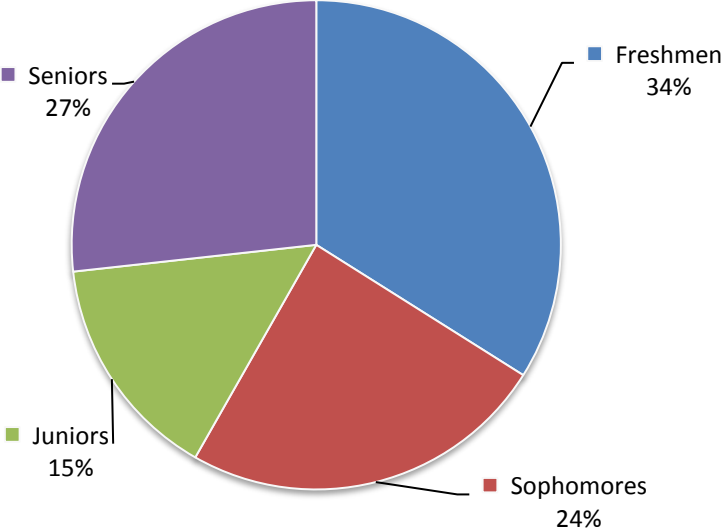
