Upward Bound Program at the University of the Virgin Islands is a college preparatory program designed to generate the skills and motivation for academic success in high school and beyond. The program provides opportunities to selected eligible high school students with academic potential who are interested in academic instruction through classroom instruction, individual and small group tutorials, individual and small group counseling, college admission information, and cultural, social, recreational, activities to its participants.

Administrative or Educational Support Unit Mission Statement:

Upward Bound Program at the University of the Virgin Islands is designed to generate the skills and motivation for academic success in high school and beyond. Upward Bound seeks to help students who have academic ability but who may not have the preparation, motivation or opportunity to realize or demonstrate their full potential, and go on to earn a four year degree at a institution of higher learning.

- (1) Graduating high school seniors will begin a four year degree at an institution of higher learning the Fall Semester immediately following completion of high school curriculum.
- (2) Students attending the Upward Bound Program will have improved standardized test scores between pre-tests given at the beginning of the academic year and post tests given at the end of the academic year.
- (3) Students attending the Upward Bound Program will be satisfied with the counseling services provided during the academic year.
