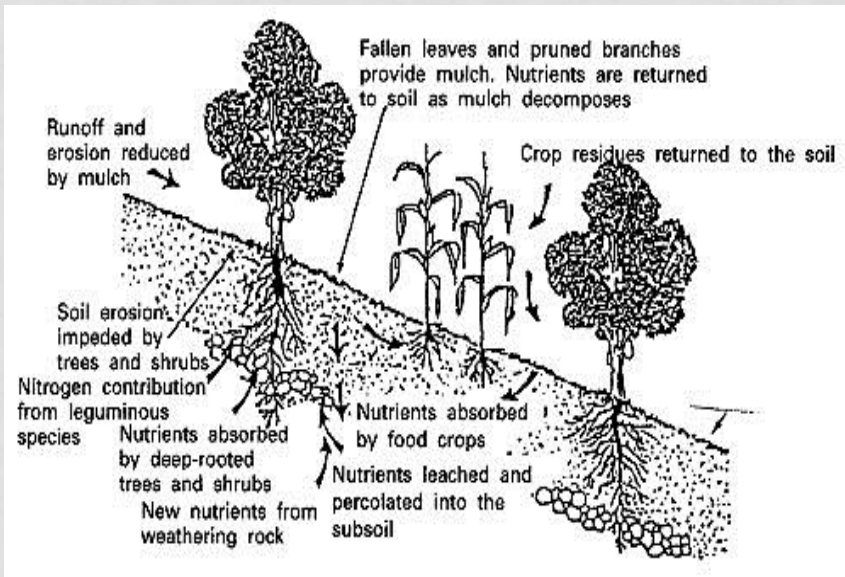

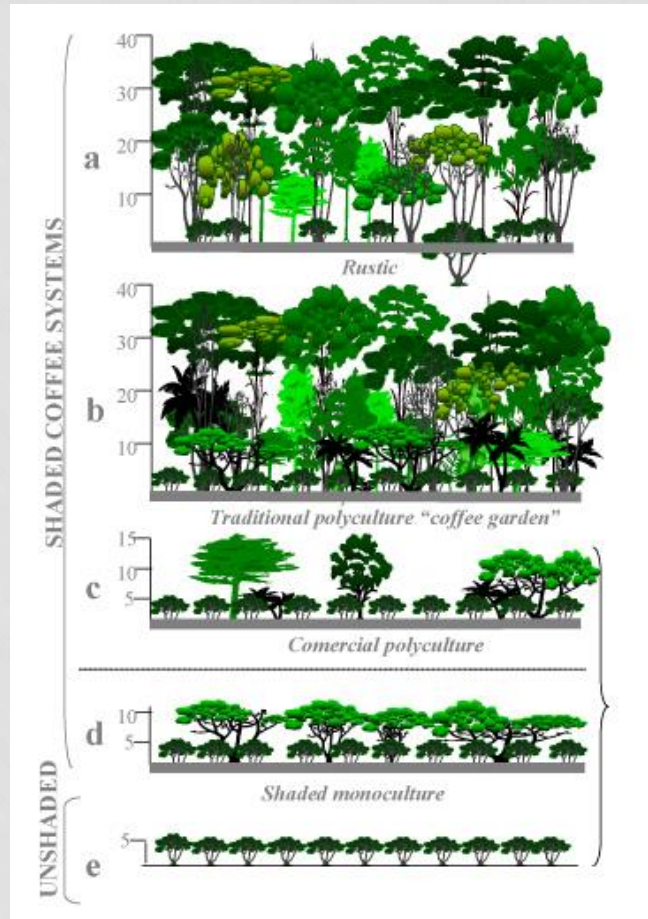
# TAUNGYA

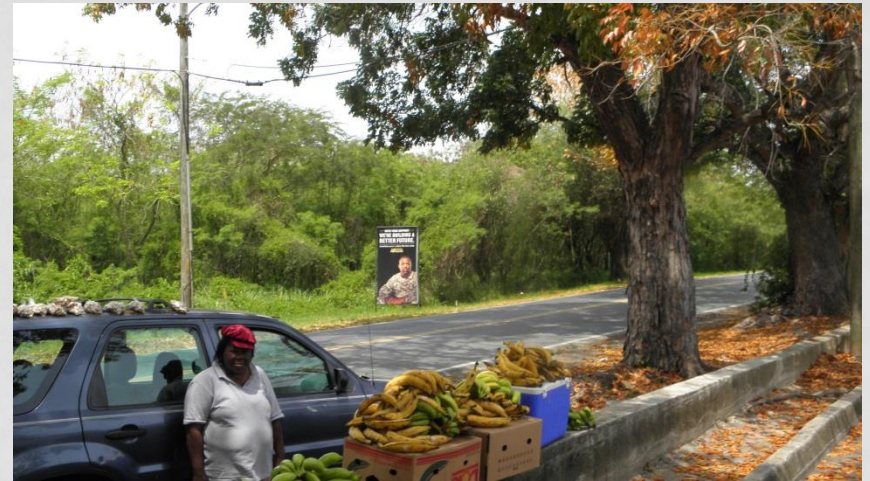
