Eligibility for Admission to the BSN Program:

- Students must have (1) a 3.0 cumulative grade point average; (2) Achieved a minimum grade of at least "C" in Science Courses and (3) a score of "Basic" or better on the ATI Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS).
- Students must meet the Computer Literacy requirement during the freshman year. Transfer students may complete 24 credits before completing this requirement.

Progression Requirements

- To progress in the nursing sequence a students must achieve a minimum grade of "C" in all nursing courses and maintain a minimum of 2.0 overall average.
- A "C" grade is defined as 75% in the School of Nursing.
- Students must pass both the theory and clinical components of nursing courses. Failure in any one component will result in a failing grade in the course.
- Only **ONE** nursing course failure is allowed in the Nursing Sequence (i.e. courses with the NUR prefix in the course code).
